The Charlevoix Conservation District is seeking a part time field position to assist with our Hunting Access Program in Charlevoix and Emmet Counties. The position hours are flexible, running mainly May-September, and includes paid training hours. The HAP field position involves working with the District Manager to coordinate and execute field work for the DNR Hunting Access Program (HAP). Work load includes working directly with landowners to assess property for hunting potential, set up hunting boundaries, signs, safety zones, a hunter welcome station and paid mileage. Experience includes aerial maps, compasses, GPS, ability to work with people and comfortable in the outdoors. Some office work may include online mapping, and outreach to promote the HAP program. Position is ideal for retirees, teachers, college students, or anyone with a flexible schedule during summer months who could use a supplemental income. \$10/hr, no benefits.

The Hunting Access Program (HAP) is a DNR program facilitated through local Conservation Districts. This landowner incentive program is designed to help with recruitment and retention of hunters in Michigan, help landowners better manage wildlife on their land and provide more hunting opportunities on private lands.
