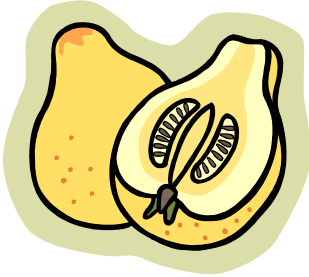


Pear Trees

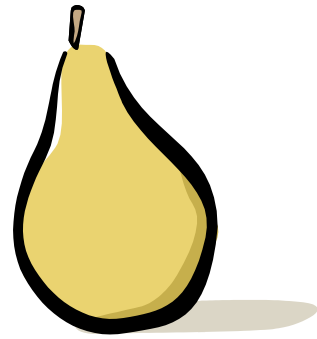


Golden Russet Bosc ®

A beautiful Bosc pear that has a very smooth russeted finish. Fruit quality and tree characteristics are the same as a regular Bosc pear. Recommended for best cross pollination with Bartlett.

Bartlett

The leading commercial variety for fresh use and processing. The fruit is medium size, pyriform with smooth yellow skin. Flesh is distinctive, smooth, juicy, excellent for canning and fresh use. Tree is very adaptable, vigorous, and productive. Susceptible to fire blight and requires cross pollination.



Please Note!

Harrow Sweet (substitute for Golden Russet Bosc)

There weren't enough Golden Russet Bosc available, so remaining orders will be filled with Harrow Sweet. This yellow pear ripens two weeks after Bartlett and one week before Golden Russet Bosc. A hardy variety that will cross pollinate with Bartlett.
