NOT glass dishes, window glass, or light bulbs.



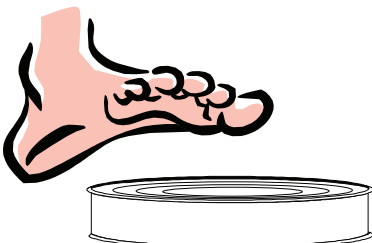
COLORED GLASS

Cardboard

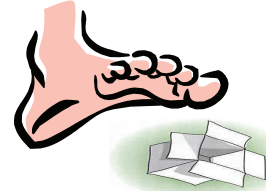
Corrugated & Greyboard

(Greyboard examples: cereal boxes, tissue boxes, paper towel cores)

Remove liners and or packing materials.
NO waxed produce boxes or greasy pizza boxes.

Cardboard Reminder:

BUSINESSES are encouraged to use the compactors located at the East Jordan and Melrose sites.

#1 and #2 plastic bottles, jugs, & jars

Please rinse, flatten and
throw away the lids.



Watch out for #3 bottles which look like #1, but are not recyclable.

Office Paper Plus

No need to remove stickers, rubber bands, staples, mailing labels, tape or paper clips. Pale or pastel-colored office paper is okay.



Please remove CDs, credit cards and other non-paper items.

NO golden-brown or manila envelopes, padded envelopes, boldly colored paper or bound documents.
